Review and if appropriate consider Conditional Approval of the Subdivision Plan for Adam and Sandra Kopp, including requested Waivers and Deferrals as presented and revised by Alpha Engineers per Twp. Engineer and DCPC and Zoning Officer review comments.

Mr. Burkhart asked the Board to review revisions made to the plans as presented by Mike Smith with Alpha Engineering and if appropriate, approve the requested Waiver of

Chap 22, Sec 304 (Preliminary Plan Processing); Deferral of Chap 22 Sec 506 (Curbs & Gutters) and Chap 22, Sec 507

(Sidewalks); and grant a <u>Conditional Approval</u> for the Preliminary/Final Subdivision Plan for Adam and Sandra Kopp.

Mike Smith presented the plan to the Board for consideration. Mr. Hershey asked Mike Smith if all technical issues were addressed, including driveway issues. Mr. Hershey asked Mr. Kenworthy and Ms. Yocum if there were any outstanding conditions needing to be addressed for approval.

Mr. Kenworthy indicated that there were no technical comments to be addressed other than any outside agency issues still outstanding, Ms. Yocum stated that there are two conditions needed to be added:

- The plan needs to be updated to specify which lots will be specified to retain the rights to future subdivision, and
- How many lots will be created in the future based on the subdivision plan.

All of the above were recommendations from the Township Planning Commission. Ms. Yocum noted that the subdivision rights would also need to be included on the property deeds. She also stated that there would also need to be an Agricultural Nuisance Plan Note included.

Lytle Farm (South Side)

The Board of Supervisors were presented with a Revised and Updated Concept Plan of the Lytle Farm (south side) development site for review and comments. Mr. Nate

Peppitone, the land owner and his legal and engineer representatives presented the proposed overview and changes. Mr. Peppitone provided a summary of how the proposed development has progressed and the agreements made with the Township. He presented the Board with a Plan he titled the "Falcon Ridge" concept. He stated the old TND does not work in today's economy due to walls and grading. Additional Issues:

- Stormwater Legacy Sediment;
- The existing gas line
- Several "By Right" design issues will need to be addressed;
- A proposed traffic light at the entrance
- Cul-de-sac lengths and entrance and exit issues;
- The proposed size of public vs. private streets and curbs.

<u>Future Item</u> – Comprehensive Plan update meeting scheduled for January 24, 2023 has been postponed until further notice.

New Business

Off-ramp Signage for Love's

Mr. Geyer asked about possible additional signage to keep tractor trailers from disrupting traffic on the Tollhouse Road exit before Love's. Mr. Brandt will work with PennDOT to try and resolve the issue.

Old Business

Tree Removals in the Right-of-Way

Ms. Yocum confirmed the Township's tree removal ordinances and provisions for felled trees. Ms. Dale recommended that this topic be included in a future Newsletter. Mr. Letavic and Mr. Brandt will work on the issue.

Executive Session

The Board of Supervisors went into Executive Session at 8:30 p.m. to discuss a legal matter with solicitor Yocum. The Board of Supervisors adjourned the Executive Session at 8:53 p.m. There were no actions taken.
