EXECUTIVE SESSION:

The Board went into Executive Session at 7:02pm to discuss legal matters regarding the Keystone Group Home.

REGULAR MEETING:

The Board reconvened at 7:30pm for the regular session.

Items Addressed:

- 1) **Citizen's Input** – None

- 2) **Manager's Report** – Steve Letavic
 Colebrook Road project timeline is on track. Preliminary design to be completed in June, at which time residents will be invited to come in and look at the plan.

Met Ed will be upgrading light bulbs on Hertzler Road at no cost to Township. Mr. Doherty requested Mr. Letavic research who is paying the electric for the lights on Hertzler Road.

Mr. Doherty motioned to approve the upgrade of the light bulbs on Hertzler Road, Mr. LeHew seconded. Motion approved.

- 3) **Planning Commission** – James Foreman
 Geyer Land Development Plan for property on Rte. 230 & Deodate Road.

Mr. LeHew motioned to deny the waiver of the Land Development Plan based on the opinion of the Solicitor that the Board may not grant waivers of Land Development Plans, Mr. Doherty seconded. Motion approved.

Mr. Foreman informed the Board that the plans for Richelle Road are available for review prior to the next Board of Supervisors meeting.

4) **New Business**

Communities That Care – Mrs. Dale had forwarded a message to the Board members showing contributions from surrounding municipalities noting that Londonderry Township does not contribute.

Mr. LeHew made the recommendation to solicit TMI to pull their funding going to the Middletown School District give those funds to the Lower Dauphin School District to fund Communities That Care.

West Shore C.O.G. – 34 Municipalities are now members of the COG. Mr. LeHew has provided meeting minutes to the township office.

T.H.A.N.K.S. – Mr. LeHew informed the Board that Cumberland County would like us to join them in using the THANKS program to help our local businesses and benefit our EMA volunteers.

Golf Course – The Board would like a tour before and after the golf course plantings have been completed.

Boy Scout Cabin – Mr. Doherty informed Mr. Letavic that the swale needed on Felker Road at the cabin has not been done as of yet. Mr. Letavic has spoken to the Road Foreman regarding this matter and will follow up with it.

County EMA Director – Mr. Shellenhamer, Fire Chief, informed the Board that Dauphin County EMA has a new Director, Steve Shaver. He has an extensive Emergency Services background, is a former police chief and member of the Boro Council of Steelton.

Frequency System – Mr. Shellenhamer informed the Board of Dauphin County's request for joining the new frequency system.
